

SHELBORNE GREENE SWIMMING POOL RULES

- Pool Hours: 7:00am – 9:00pm. No one is allowed in the pool area other than during these times.
- The pool is only for the use of Shelborne Greene Homeowners/Residents and their Guests. DO NOT open the gate for a Non-Resident unless he/she is your Guest.
- Any Homeowner/Resident or Guest under the age of fourteen (14) must be accompanied by an Adult Homeowner/Resident eighteen (18) years or older.
- Swim at your own risk. No lifeguard is on duty at any time.
- All bathers must use the appropriate swim wear in the pool. Babies must be in swim diapers. Street clothes & regular diapers can clog pool filters. No shoes are allowed in the pool unless proper swim shoes.
- No diving is allowed.
- No running, pushing, shoving, dunking, boisterous or rough play, or any unsafe activities are permitted in or around the pool area.
- No loud music or other noises.
- No glass containers are allowed. Drinks or snacks are not allowed within the pool.
- No alcohol is allowed in the pool area.
- No grills of any kind (electric, gas, or charcoal) are permitted in the pool area.
- No smoking.
- No soap or other foreign substances are permitted in the pool.
- No pets allowed in the swimming pool area, except for service animals such as seeing-eye dogs.
- All trash must be properly removed to the trash containers.
- Upon leaving please close umbrellas and put chairs back to their original location.
- Any persons having any apparent skin disease, sore, or inflamed eyes, cough, cold, nasal or ear discharge, upset stomach or any communicable disease shall not use the pool.
- Members of the HOA Board, their authorized designees, and the Management Company may remove anyone from the pool area for violating rules and, if conditions warrant, close the pool.
- Violations of the rules may result in the Homeowner/Resident's household having swimming pool privileges suspended.
- Overdue HOA Dues can result in the Homeowner's household having swimming pool privileges suspended.
- Neither the HOA nor the Management Company is responsible for injuries to homeowners or guests while using any recreational facility, including the Pool and Pool Area.
- The Homeowner is responsible for any damages caused by the homeowner and/or their guest(s).
